HENDERSON MIDDLE SCHOOL CELL PHONE POLICY



Cell phones are not to be used for personal use during instructional times.

Cell phones should be turned off and out of sight during instructional and transitional times.

Cell phones should not be operated during breakfast or lunch.

Ear buds should be out of sight unless used inside the classroom for instructional purposes.

If a student violates this schoolwide policy, then:

The teacher may confiscate the phone and give it back at the end of the day / Connections teachers may give the phone back at the end of the class. (1st Offense)

Parents will need to pick up the cell phone on the 2nd Offense and Subsequent Offenses.

If a student repeatedly violates the cell phone policy, the student will be subject to disciplinary action.
