

Henderson Middle School – How to Guide for Students and Parents



Hours

- School opens at 8:25 am to go to homeroom. Parents can drop students off starting at 8:25.
- Instructional time starts at 8:50 am. Arriving after 8:50 am is tardy.
- School ends at 3:50 pm. Parents must pick up all car riders no later than 4:30.

Breakfast and Lunch

- PRICES: Breakfast is \$1.80 (reduced price is 0.30). Lunch is \$3.00 (reduced price is 0.40). Cash or prepaid in account only.

Mask Wearing Protocols

 Masks are optional. Students that are COVID positive should stay home for at least 5 days. Contact your child's teachers for assignments.

Hall Pass / Lockers

- Students should always have a pass while in the hallways without a teacher.
- Lockers are assigned in the first week of school; combination lock provided. Do NOT share your combination with anyone.
- Students need their own combination lock for the locker room if they need to change before / after PE class.

Classes and Credits

- English Language Arts (ELA), Math, Science, Social Studies, Extended Learning Time (ELT), World Languages for 7/8th grades.
- Students can earn Carnegie Units (credit towards high school graduation) for World Languages.
- HMS offers Carnegie Units for Accelerated Math and Dual Language Immersion Programs (DLI)
- Choice of Chorus, Orchestra, Band, or Connections.
 Connections change every 9 weeks and include: Business Ed, Visual Arts, Technology, Music Appreciation, PE / Health

Grades

- Progress Reports are sent every 9 weeks. Report cards are sent each semester.
- Students and parents should keep track of all assignments, tests, and grades on <u>Infinite Campus</u>

Media Center/Library

- Students need a pass to enter the media center.
- Book checkout is for two weeks. A fine will be assessed for books returned after the due date.
- Up to 3 books can be checked out at one time.

Activities (before or after school)

- Listen to <u>Daily Announcements</u> for club information and start dates.
- Students need passes to enter the building before 8:25.
- Parents must pick up students promptly at the end of an afterschool activity.

Forgotten Items

- Students should be prepared for the school day, but we understand emergencies happen. Interruptions during instructional time must be kept to a minimum.
- Forgotten items must be dropped off in the attendance office or at the security desk. Please include the student's full name and grade on the item being dropped off.

Problems

- Counselors can help with academic, social, and/or emotional problems.
- Students can sign up between classes for an appointment.

Medications

- Necessary medications are stored in the nurse's office
- Written permission, labels, and instructions must be provided.

Absences

- Students returning from an absence must bring documentation (paper note) with a valid excuse signed by a parent or a doctor.
 If a valid excuse is not turned in, the absence will be marked unexcused.
- Excused absences include illness, medical appointments, a
 death in the immediate family, mandated court appearances
 and emergencies beyond one's control. You may also refer to
 the <u>Student Code of Conduct handbook</u> for further information.

Missed Schoolwork

- Students are responsible for talking with teachers about missed assignments.
- Give teachers 24 hours to gather work.
- For absences of more than 3 consecutive days, parents should contact their grade level counselor for homework and make up assignments. Teachers can NOT interrupt instructional time to provide them to you.

Late Check-Ins and Early Check-Outs

- Any student arriving after 8:50 am is considered tardy and must have a doctor's note or a parent must come in to sign them in. Otherwise, the student will have an <u>unexcused tardy</u>.
- Students must be checked out in the attendance office whether for illness or appointments.
- Check-out <u>can occur no later than 3:15pm</u>. Parents who arrive after 3:15 for check-out must wait in the carpool pickup line.
- A parent or guardian (or other authorized adult) must pick up students in person and bring ID. Authorized adults must be listed on the Student Information Sheet OR in Infinite Campus. If the adult is not listed, they will not be able to check the student out.
- The attendance office will call the student to the front. Please arrive with enough time for student check out.

Brief Behavior Expectations: Student Code of Conduct here

- Be on time and prepared.
- Show respect. Don't use profane or obscene words or gestures.
- Hats, sunglasses, cameras, and skateboards are NOT permitted on campus.
- Bookbags and other large bags must be kept in lockers during the school day.
- No selling anything without approval from administration.
- Cell phones may NOT be used in hallways, gym, bathrooms, locker rooms, the cafeteria, or during instructional time.

Dress Code: Student Code of Conduct here

- Appearance must be neat, clean, and appropriate.
- NO flip flops or slides for student safety.
- Jackets, coats, and hats must be kept in lockers during the day.
- Pants, shorts, and skirts must be worn at the waist.
- Clothing length should be mid-thigh.
- Clothing with rips or tears is prohibited unless leggings are worn underneath.
- Clothing must be fitted to cover undergarments, including during movement.

Cell Phones

- Dekalb County School District policy is that students may NOT use cell phones for conversation or text messaging during the school day.
- Cell phones may NOT be used in hallways, gym, bathrooms, locker rooms, the cafeteria, or during instructional time.

Visitors

- Parents must check-in at the security desk to sign in and receive a visitor badae.
- No general visitors are allowed without approval.
